

- Guests must present a negative PCR test result upon entry into Switzerland. This test obligation also applies to vaccinated and recovered persons. In addition, a second test, PCR or rapid antigen test, must be carried out between the fourth and seventh day after entry. The test costs must be paid by the entrants themselves.
- Those entering from border regions (e.g. Baden-Württemberg in Germany) are exempt from the testing obligation.
- Hotels are obliged to check the presence of a test for guests from abroad (except border regions). If no test is available, the guest must take it immediately and the person must be reported to the canton.
- Non-vaccinated third-country nationals who wish to enter the Schengen area from risk countries or regions will be refused entry to Switzerland for temporary stays. Tourism and visiting stays are particularly affected.
